We optimise our cutting programmes to minimise board off cuts.

Sawdust

This comes from the cutting and drilling we do during the manufacturing process.

• Cardboard and Paper

From the packaging of our standard and Bespoke range of products and also the paper used within the administration process.

Metal

All the metal waste coming from the manufacturing process is recycled.

• IT Equipment

Even when our IT Equipment is replaced and updated, nothing is thrown away. This is collated and sent for recycling.






Title goods
